As part of the pandemic recovery programme the government have dedicated funding to the 'Plan for Jobs' scheme. This project is set to hire 13,500 new Work Coaches across the country in a bid to revitalise the hard hit labour market. The expansion involves refurbishing existing space in the same building where Jobcentre Plus is already based.

On this project we installed British Gypsum metal stud partitions, drylining with plaster finish and Ecophon Suspended Ceilings.
